Pinot Noir, Santa Barbara County 2019

Dry, Red, Still wine

100% Pinot Noir

Yeast: Native. Elevage: French oak barrels. Fining/Filtering: None. A combination of whole cluster and destemmed pinot noir. The fruit is sorted by hand then loaded into large, oak open top fermentors. We gently extract using both punch downs and pump overs during fermentation, once dry we will press and let the wine quickly settle before going down to a third new french oak barrels. On the lees for 8-9 months we then rack and blend to stainless steel prior to bottling. A clarity and purity that is nearly impossible to find at this price point in a Pinot Noir

About us

A son of Santa Barbara, Justin Tyler Willett began Tyler in 2005 at the age of 24 with a few barrels tucked away in the corner of the Sta. Rita Hills cellar he was working in at the time. It was there, as the assistant winemaker, he honed his approach to Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. Justin – a champion of old vines – has since engaged the famed historic vineyards of Santa Barbara, including the region-defining Sanford & Benedict, in the Santa Rita Hills. Great effort has been made to seek out vineyards of pedigree and establish close collaboration with those growers. New: Mae Estate Vineyard.
