## Chianti Classico Brolio 2019

Italy > Tuscany > Chianti Classico

Dry, Red, Still wine

80% Sangiovese, 15% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Sauvignon

The vineyards which produce the grapes for the Brolio label are planted in five geological areas at an elevation between 280 meters to 480 meters (919 to 1,575 feet high) and with different exposures. Vineyard soils vary greatly but all are strewn with stony fragments adding mineral richness. This exalts the structure of the Chianti Classico vintage.

### About us

Ricasoli is the most representative wine producer in the Chianti Classico area and one of the ten oldest family businesses in the world. The Castello di Brolio estate, located in the commune of Gaiole in Chianti nestled among gentle hills and dense woodlands of oaks and chestnuts, is spread out over 1,200 hectares, of which almost 240 hectares is dedicated to vineyards and 26 to olive groves. Castello di Brolio is also a place where wine lovers from Italy and abroad and enthusiasts of Italy's cultural heritage can choose from one of a variety of visits, itineraries and tours.
